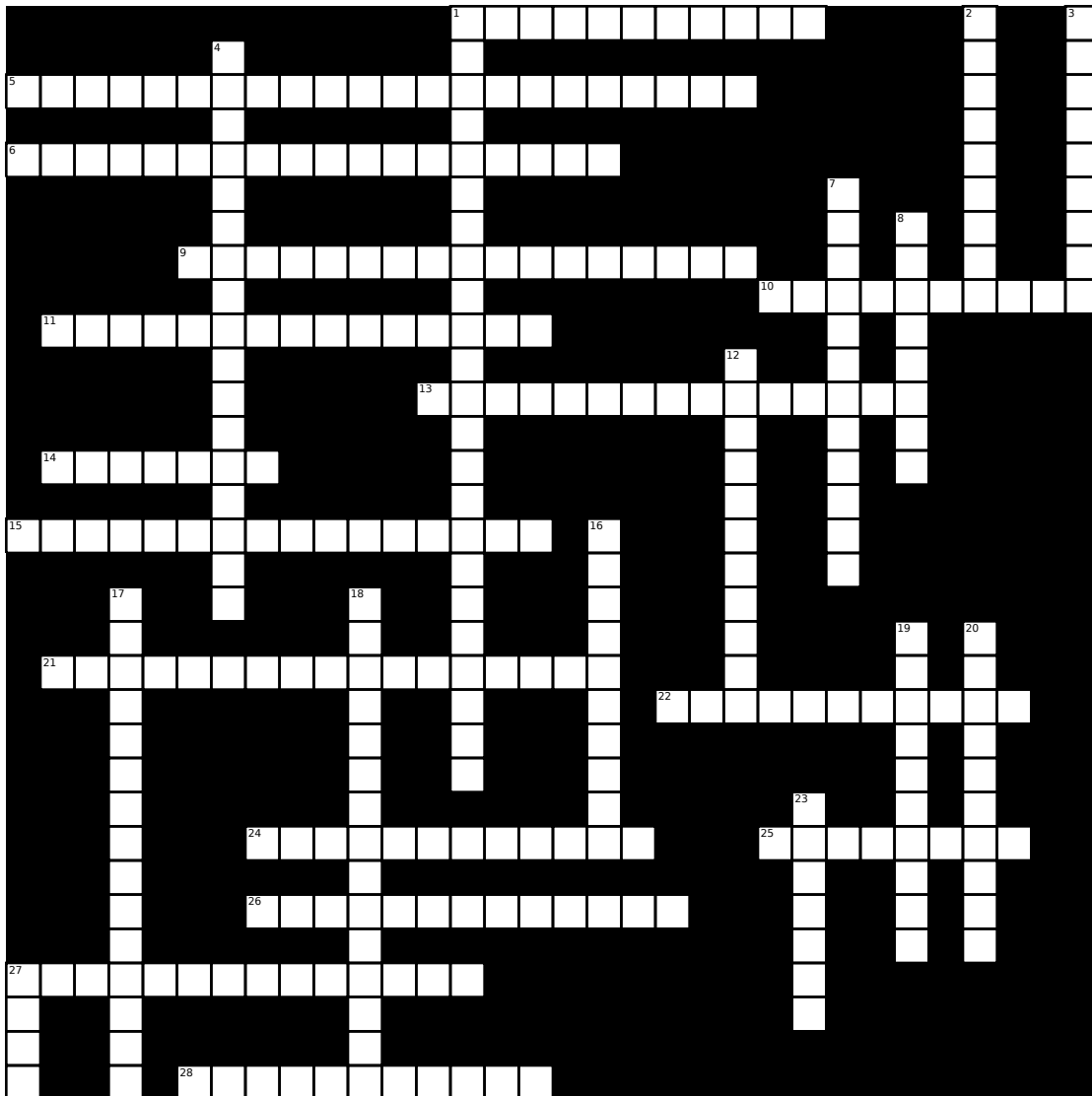

- 16 The President that sent federal troops to Little Rock
- 17 The Supreme Court case ruled in favor of the students and their peaceful protest
- 18 Forbade literacy tests and other voting restrictions
- 19 Rosa Parks was honored for her part in this in Montgomery
- 20 Second most influential Supreme Court Justice
- 23 The President that ordered a naval quarantine of Cuba
- 27 The U.S. began a trade embargo against this country in the 1960s
